FGPTA Protocols/Guidelines for Events & Meetings for PTA Board, Chairs & Volunteers:

<p>Symptom Checks</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At home <u>and</u> before arrival to FG PTA events/meetings, all participants should go through a visual symptoms check for COVID illness symptoms: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Headache 2. Chills 3. Cough 4. Sore throat 5. Congestions (not related to allergies or asthma) 6. New loss of taste or smell 7. Difficulty breathing (not related to asthma) 8. Muscle/body aches 9. Stomachache 10. Diarrhea 11. Fatigue 12. Temperature check • CDC Symptoms Chart with Symptoms Icons • If any participant(s) and/or family member of participant(s) appears unwell and/or has a fever (99.0-100.4 or greater), all participant(s) should remain at home and not attend the event/meeting. Parents/guardian follow-up with their health provider is recommended.
<p>Procedures for Participant Check-In/Arrival & Check-Out/Departure</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All participants attending events/meetings should check-in and check-out with a Facilitron QR code. • All adult volunteers who will be interacting and working with children <u>must have on file with PGUSD</u> a completed Volunteer Packet, Department of Justice clearance (finger printing), and submitted proof of COVID-19 vaccination. Volunteers, who have not completed this process, will not be allowed to participate at PTA events/meetings. • A list of adult volunteers will be cross-referenced for compliance with PGUSD volunteer protocols.
<p>Mask Use</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All participants, regardless of age or vaccination status, will be required to wear a mask at all INDOOR events/meetings, following county, state and PGUSD guidelines and protocols. • Mask use is optional at OUTDOOR events/meetings but are encouraged.
<p>Health & Sanitary</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All participants permitted at the event will either wash hands upon entering events/meetings or use hand-sanitizer. • Prior to events/meetings, the space (tables, chairs, high touch areas, etc.) will be cleaned with PGUSD-approved sanitizer and doors/windows will be opened for ventilation. • When at all possible (event facility space needs/weather-permitting), events will be held outdoors in the open-air.
<p>Food & Beverage Services</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All food and beverages offered at events/meetings will be served in individually wrapped and commercial packaging. No homemade goods will be served. • Outside food vendors scheduled to participate in events will have current business health/sanitary licenses and procedures in place that follow county and CA state protocols to serve the general public. • When food and beverages are consumed at indoor events/meetings, participants will be encouraged to eat outdoors and/or maintain a 3-6ft. social distance, as masks will be off during consumption. Masks are required to be put on after eating/drinking at INDOOR events/meetings.
